License fees paid by Foreign Vessel for fishing in the vast EEZ is a major source of income to the country. Copra and fish now represent the bulk of production and exports. Economic development is constrained by a shortage of skilled workers, weak infrastructure, and remoteness from international markets. The country is particularly seen as vulnerable to effects of rising sea levels.
